The traditional Day Camp is our most popular program. Camps are theme oriented with a different adventure every week. Camp counselors plan various group activities, arts and crafts, games and fun that compliment each theme. Outdoor swimming will be offered at various times daily. Weekly day trips are a vital part of day camp as well. It is very important to check the schedule for the week. Arriving late could result in loss of care for the day. Campers are divided by grade level, based on the grade they will be attending for the 2009-10 school year though they often join with other grades for assorted activities. This camp is designed for grades 1-6. Campers that are going into the 7th grade and up for the 2009-10 school year are encouraged to sign-up for the specialty camps provided, but will not be turned away if interested.

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### IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW:

1. All campers must hold a valid YMCA membership from June thru August to receive the member rate.
2. Register at the front desk no later than the Wednesday before the week you are interested in having your child in camp. Pre-payment is required before your child will be accepted at camp. No exceptions.
3. Registration forms are available at the front desk of the YMCA.

### TRANSPORTATION:

The Duneland School Cooperation will provide transportation for field trips. Your child must be at the YMCA no later than the scheduled time. Otherwise, you are responsible for getting them to the location of Camp.

### SCHOLARSHIPS:

Scholarships are available to those needing help to pay for camp. Scholarship forms are located at the front desk. DEADLINE for day camp scholarship applications is May 30, 2009.

### COUNSELOR IN TRAINING (CIT):

This program is for older youth between the ages of 13-16 that have the desire to learn how to be a camp counselor. This program will have a mentor that trains the CIT's on safety, child abuse prevention, and curriculum planning. There will be a minimal cost of \$35 per week for participation in this program, which consists of field trip fees, transportation, snack fees, and trainer fees. There are limited spots available and an interview is required for acceptance. Please call 926-4204 for more information or to schedule and interview.

### SPECIALTY CAMPS:

These are Duneland Family YMCA Specialty Camps for those campers that would like the opportunity to try new and exciting things or to strengthen their skills in a sport or specialty that they already have. All specialty campers will go to their specified camp Monday thru Thursday and then on Friday they will have the option to join up with the traditional day camp participants for the field trips or be picked up by a parent. Please check the times and fees listed for each individual camp offered. If you want extended care when specialty camp is over, you must be at least a summer YMCA member and it will be an additional \$60 per week and you must be registered.
